Etonbury Academy is a member of the Schools Farm Network Education Alliance – This means you will get the opportunity to visit and even stay at the Royal Agricultural University!





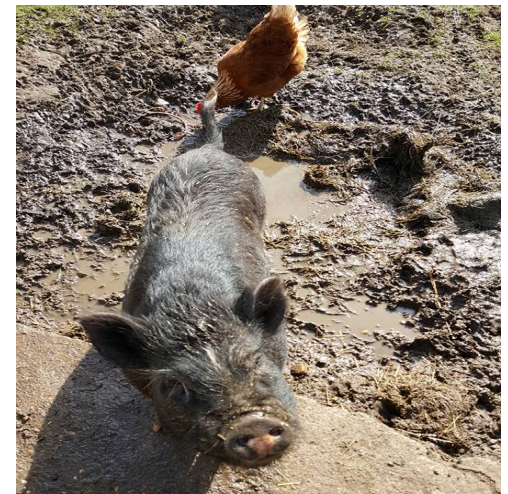
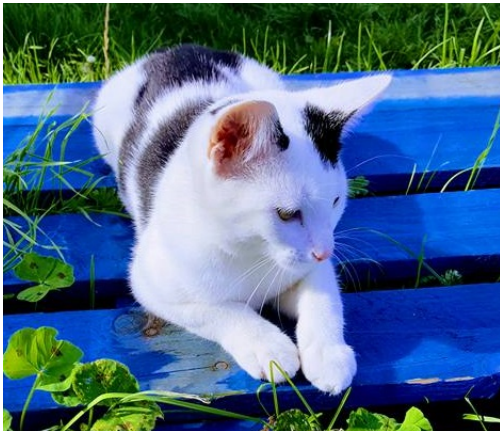
