This summer has also produced a wonderful season of athletics for the students at Etonbury, with a fantastic mixture of personal performances, teamwork and resilience displayed by all. Our Secondary Sports day winning house was **Thatchers** and for our ETA Juniors was **Foresters**! Well done everyone, a fantastic example of The ETA Way!

There have been a phenomenal number of events, activities and trips this year, over 50 in fact! All run by members of staff across the whole school - thank you everyone for providing all of these opportunities for our students! This year over 1800 pupils have attended a school visit or trip to complement and support their teaching and learning, expand their subject knowledge and provide a learning opportunity outside the classroom.



This week we were delighted to collaborate with Samuel Whitbread Academy as we attended an

enlightening Black Heritage Seminar. Sharon De Leonardis led the session where students engaged in research and art activities, creating stunning works honouring Black inventors. A truly inspiring day of learning and celebration!

It gives me great pleasure to share our budding scientists for the summer term who were nominated by their teachers for demonstrating amazing practical skills, fantastic effort and incredible attitude to learning in their science lessons. Earlier this week some students had the experience to see into the heart of where the power lays in the

UK, standing along the pews in the house of commons whilst learning the history and the rules that govern the MPs when they are debating there. With strict instructions not to sit in the seats, the students discovered the role of the speaker of the house of commons and why MPs have to bow on entry. They also had the opportunity to see the house of Lords as it was being prepared for the King's arrival to re-open Parliament on Wednesday, with both thrones being polished and gleaming.

Following this, students had the chance to explore the Imperial War Museum, including the Holocaust Gallery, before making their way to the Churchill War Rooms; an enormous



underground bunker. The audio tour experienced by our young people brought that challenging period of our History into sharp focus, with students learning about Churchills very quirky character, and the restrictions faced by all staff living there.

This week Mrs Bramacahari-Limb led our School of Rock production. There were three spectacular performances of the show across three evenings, each and every one of the crew and cast were amazing. #### **GCSE Speaking and Listening Exam**

Year 9 students have been working hard this term to produce speeches that will be presented in October for their formal GCSE Speaking and Listening Exam. In September, all students will be told the date and time of their examination, which will be assessed in small groups. Over the summer, students are encouraged to rehearse their speech and make any final edits. Students should remember that they are not allowed a script in their exam, but can have their flashcards to aid memory. Students will be awarded a pass, merit or distinction mark for their exam and the results will be printed on their GCSE exam certificates, so it is important that all students try their hardest to succeed to the best of their ability.

# **GCSE Results Day**

This year, GCSE results day will be held on Thursday the 22nd of August. Students can arrive between 8:30 and 11am to collect their results. Please enter the school via the new reception and collect results from the new sixth form block. Parents are able to wait for students in the sixth form garden.

Students will be asked to sign for their results and sign consent for their scripts. Exam scripts are gained for departments to use as teaching and learning professional development as well as to help advise on reviews of marking.

If students cannot come into school to collect their results, the following may be arranged:

- A nominated person can collect them on your behalf but they must have a letter of authorisation <u>from the student</u>. To authorise this please email our exams officer Mrs Williams at: <u>gwilliams@bestacademies.org.uk</u>. Please note that this nominated person may be asked for a photographic ID before results are given out.
- Results can be posted home but you must supply a stamped self-addressed envelope to the exams office no later than 17th July 2024.
- A PDF of results can be emailed to the students' school email address, which will be emailed by midday, this must be requested by the student no later than 17th July 2024.

If you have applied to Etonbury Sixth Form, you will receive a letter in your results pack, informing you of your acceptance, or if a discussion is required with Mrs Dowden. You will also need to confirm or

decline your place in the Sixth Form by completing the slip and returning it to us before you leave. If you need an appointment with Mrs Dowden because you would like to discuss/change your options, you will be able to book these on the day once you have collected your results. These will take place in the afternoon from 12pm.
