The inspection was conducted under section 8 of the Education Act 2005, which is an ungraded inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether the school has taken action to maintain the standards identified during the previous inspection in 2020, which was graded 'Good'. Ofsted do not give graded judgments on an ungraded inspection.

We are delighted with the report and the outcomes from the inspection team. The report describes what our pupils, parents, staff and visitors tell us, that we are a welcoming school, treat each other with kindness and expect the very best.

The report celebrates pupils' strong sense of belonging to the school community, how they feel safe, cared for and known as individuals and the consistently strong outcomes they achieve.
