



Dear Parents/Carers,

Our annual Sports day will take place this year on **Monday 13th July**.

The morning will be an **inclusive sports event for all pupils**, featuring a variety of activities including **netball, football, handball, softball, and rounders**. All children will take part in these sessions as part of a celebration of sport and teamwork.

In the afternoon, we have traditional **track and field events**. Unfortunately, it is not possible for all pupils to take part in these events. Therefore, pupils have been taking part in competitions during PE lessons to earn their place in these races. You are warmly invited to come and watch the track events, however, please check with your child beforehand to confirm whether they have been selected to take part in these races.

Important Information:

- **Spectators are only permitted during the afternoon session (2:15pm–3:15pm, arrival from 2.00pm)** due to safeguarding, as the morning events take place across multiple academy facilities.
- **All pupils will participate in the morning events**, but unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate spectators at that time.
- **A maximum of 2 spectators per child** is allowed. If you plan to attend, please complete the Google Form using the link provided below.
- To respect the privacy and safety of all pupils, **no photography is allowed**, and we kindly ask that **mobile phones remain away** throughout the event.
- There will be **no car parking** available on the day, spectators are encouraged to walk to our site.
- **Access to the school field** will be via the staff car park where you will be registered by a member of staff on your arrival.
