**Public transport** - The government guidance requests that pupils and parents should be encouraged not to use public transport and that pupils should be encouraged to walk or cycle to school where possible. Where this is not possible, pupils and parents should read the <u>safer travel guidance for</u> <u>passengers</u>. If you do plan to use public transport, we have been trying to engage with both Arriva and Centrebus for the past few weeks on your behalf and have received a response from Centrebus below but have not received any information from Arriva as yet. Due to the slight changes in the school day for Year 5 and 6, the bus will arrive 'in time for lessons' if it is in service, so there is no need to worry about your child missing any lesson time.

'At the moment we are still awaiting government guidance on school services/journeys for September, so I am unable to comment what arrangements will be in place at the moment. The 96/96A is funded by Central Bedfordshire Council, so we will be working closely with them to meet any requirements that they put in place.
