### **What is LAMDA?**

LAMDA is a world-class drama school in London that offers exams resulting in qualifications in both Speech and Drama that are recognized around the world through their Speech and Communications Board overseen by OFQUAL. Students can try their hand at Public Speaking, Acting, Verse and Prose and Reading for Performance. The aim is to develop a love, appreciation and understanding of language and literature through learning and speaking aloud, and to offer a progressive education and training in communication through speech.

### **What are the benefits of LAMDA?**
