Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our ongoing commitment to working in partnership with families, we are pleased to introduce **Provision Map**—our online platform for managing and sharing your child's Individual Support Plan (ISP).

Provision Map gives you secure online access to your child's ISP, allowing you to view their plan at any time and stay up to date with the support being put in place.

You will shortly receive an email from the school containing a unique access code and instructions on how to log in. If you do not receive this email over the next few weeks, or if you experience any difficulties logging in, please contact the SEND team and we will be happy to assist you.

Your child's ISP will be reviewed each term alongside you and your child. We want these plans to be collaborative documents that accurately reflect your child's strengths, needs, and aspirations. Through the platform, you can add your comments and feedback directly to the plan. We strongly encourage you to do so, as your views are essential in helping us provide the best possible support.

Each plan includes clear, personalised targets tailored to your child's needs. These targets will be reviewed regularly and updated as your child makes progress or as their needs change.

Alongside these support targets, we are introducing two exciting new areas:

- **Personal Growth Target** – This will be chosen by your child and is designed to encourage them to work towards something that is personally meaningful. This could be learning to ride a skateboard, building confidence in speaking to new people, learning to cook, or overcoming a personal fear. The aim is to celebrate personal development beyond the classroom.
- **Preparing for Adulthood Target** – This target will be supported by parents and carers at home and is intended to help your child develop the skills and experiences they will need as they move towards adulthood. This could include learning to travel independently, managing money, ordering food in a café, completing household chores, or trying a new activity that stretches them beyond their comfort zone. We have provided a list of example ideas to help you get started.





In addition to the ISP, every student will also have a Pupil Passport. This is an 'All About Me' profile that provides staff with valuable information about your child, including their strengths, interests, preferred ways of learning and any strategies that help them to succeed. This will enable all staff to get to know your child better and provide consistent support across the school.

We would be grateful if you could **complete the Google Form linked [here](#)**. The information you provide will help us create your child's new ISP and Pupil Passport, ensuring they accurately reflect your child's needs and aspirations from the very beginning of September.
