#### **MenB (meningococcal B) vaccination programme from July 2026**

The Government is introducing a free one-off, [time-limited MenB \(meningococcal B\) vaccination programme](#) from July 2026 for young people. You are eligible if:

You are born between 1st September 2007 to 31st August 2008.

You turn 25 years of age after 31st December 2026 and will be a first-time university student, including international students, in the 2026/27 academic year.

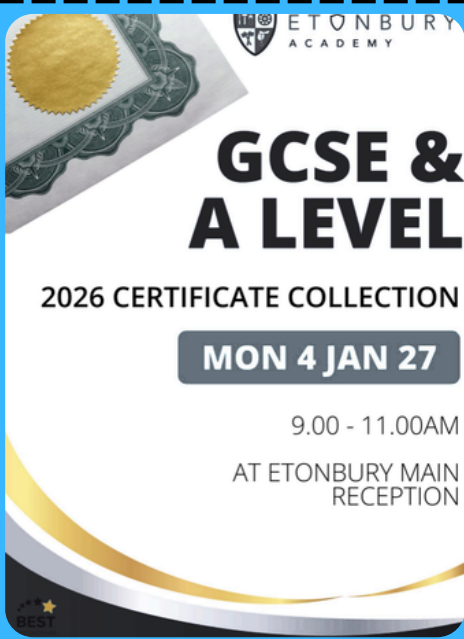
You turn 25 years of age after 31<sup>st</sup> December 2026 and will be a first-time further education student living in halls or shared accommodation at specific settings in the 2026/27 academic year
