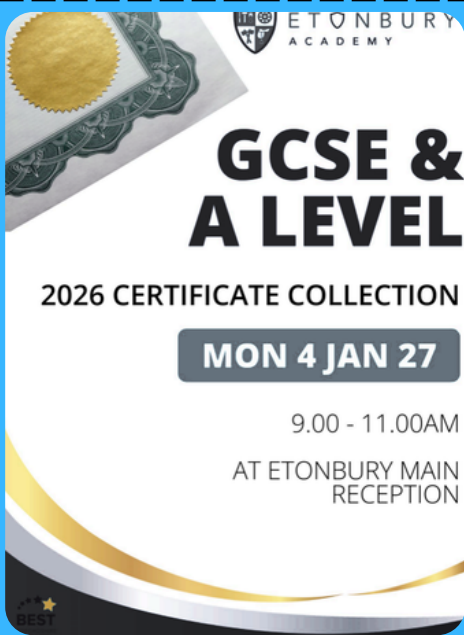
Work Experience - Year 12- Monday 29th June to Friday 3rd July
