The Year 12 mocks are running from Thursday 19th June to Wednesday 25th June. You will now be able to view your child's timetable in the MCAS app under 'Examination Timetables'. Please note that that exams are listed in alphabetical order rather than date order. You are able to change this by clicking the header 'Exam Date' and the exams will then be sorted into date order. Mock exams are run in line with JCQ guidance. Throughout the mock exam period, students must report to Sixth Form - 30 minutes prior to their exams scheduled start time. This will allow us to register, brief and support students fully prior to their exams. Year 12 Mock Exam and Work Experience Arrangements

Monday 16th-Wednesday 18th June: In school attending lessons as usual

Thursday 19th-Wednesday 25th June:On study leave - attending school for exams only

Thursday 26th-Friday 27th June: Students to work independently from home on researching their next steps using the Unifrog tool. Preparing their CV's, setting up their LinkedIn accounts and identifying what course/apprenticeship or Job they may choose to embark upon post Sixth Form. Students applying to university must use this time to start their UCAS statements.

Monday 30th -Friday 4th July: Students are on their WEX - those students who have not secured a placement must come into school for the whole week, where they will complete a week of virtual work experience.

Monday 7th July: All students to attend Sixth Form as usual.
