Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find included with this letter your child's academic tracking sheet.

For core subjects (English, maths and science) all students have been given a minimum expected target for them to reach before the end of year 7. Teachers have then given an assessment of how your child is progressing and indicated a future focus action to ensure progress is maintained or improved.

The grade entered by teachers will be one of the following:

**Exceeding** - it is anticipated your child will surpass their minimum target **In Line -** your child is expected to reach the minimum target **Below** - the teacher does not feel your child will meet the minimum target Causing Concern - there are concerns about the progress being made by your child

For all non-core subjects, students are working on developing subject specific skills, appropriate to their year group, that are needed to be successful in the subject. The teacher has provided a judgement as to how well your child is acquiring these skills.

The judgement entered by teachers will be one of the following:

**Mastery** - skills are highly developed and being applied well most of the time **Secure** - a good level of skill has been developed and can be applied some of the time **Emerging** - some skills have been acquired and the application of them is developing

You will also find details of your child's attendance, merits and behaviour points.
