



## <u>Year 10 Geography Fieldtrip to Sheringham, North Norfolk. Wednesday 17th</u> <u>- Friday 19th July 2024</u>

The Geography Department is proposing to run a residential field trip for Year 10 Geography pupils to Sheringham, North Norfolk. The field trip is undertaken to provide pupils with the fieldwork they will need for the Paper 3 exam in summer 2023 and for this reason we would hope all students are able to attend. The trip will also provide a series of excellent first-hand case studies along Norfolk's fascinating coastline that will enhance their classroom studies.

As part of the GCSE geography course, students need to undertake two geographical enquiries, each of which must include the use of primary data, collected as part of a fieldwork exercise. Fieldwork is an essential aspect of geography. It ensures that students are given the opportunity to consolidate and extend their geographical understanding by relating learning to real experiences of the world.

We will be staying at the YHA Sheringham, a specialist field centre. The trip will leave Etonbury Academy at 8am on Wednesday 17th July and return for 1pm on Friday 19th July.

The cost of the trip will be **£170** per pupil, which will cover the cost of accommodation, transport, food and resources. This is a voluntary contribution, but if we do not receive sufficient funds, the trip may not go ahead.
