Last Friday 12th January we welcomed the Regional Director for Schools (East of England) -Johnathan Duff to Etonbury Academy. It was a perfect opportunity to showcase our wonderful school,

staff and students, our achievements and the opening of the new Sixth Form. Mr Duff was highly complementary of the confidence shown by the students he and his team met, sharing how articulate, confident and the clarity in the way they spoke about their time at Etonbury.

Regular consultations between Teachers and Parents/Carers are crucial in celebrating success, in monitoring progress and agreeing targets and actions for improvement. This week parent consultations took place virtually across two evenings for Year 11 students. This provided the opportunity for quality discussions regarding mock exam results and mapping out



work, interventions and revision over this last full term of study for the year group. Nearly every student attended these evenings and thank you for engaging with us at this important time in your child's education.

Students from Year 5,6,7,8 who attend our Young Voices club performed at the O2 Arena this Thursday evening. # MATHS DEPARTMENT



The mathematics department are a team of specialist mathematicians who have been together at Etonbury for 5 years and they share almost 90 years of teaching experience between 5 colleagues.

In 2023, we were delighted when the GCSE Mathematics results showed that we achieved the best results across the whole of Central Bedfordshire. Many of this fantastic cohort of students are now the first group of A Level Mathematics/A Level Further Mathematics students. To be able to offer Further Mathematics in the first year of there being a sixth form is quite unusual and testament to the hard work and ethos of our students.

We ascribe much of the success to our strong ethos of promoting independent learning, resilience and ensuring that students practise key skills and develop their fluency and understanding of how to solve problems by breaking them down into small steps, making clear links to the world around us, in workplaces, for leisure and in nature.



Mr Vanner has been leading departments in a number of schools in Beds, Bucks, Northamptonshire and Luton since before the millennium.

Mrs Sarup, our current 2<sup>nd</sup> in department has previously run departments in Bedfordshire schools in and around Bedford, at all Key Stages.

Mr Beckwith is a vastly experienced teacher, who has held management positions for mathematics in previous schools and is currently enjoying his roles as a Key Stage manager for Years 9 and 10, as well as being a teacher governor.

Mr Scott started his career at Etonbury six years ago, when

ETA had its first ever cohort of GCSE students and is now leading the A Level Mathematics and A Level Further Mathematics courses, with our first cohort of sixth form students.

Mr Sutcliffe started his career at Etonbury five years ago and is the Head of Year 11. He is known for being relentless in his pursuit of helping his year group achieve their very best as they work towards their GCSE examinations. He somehow finds the time to also run the highly successful GCSE Further Mathematics course on Wednesdays after school, where Year 10 and Year 11 work towards achieving

an additional qualification that provides enrichment and depth to their GCSE knowledge, also preparing students for A Level Mathematics and A Level Further Mathematics.

As the school grows, we look forward to a new colleague joining us after Easter, Ms Potter.

We work together to ensure that all ETA students get the best deal possible. Our current Year 11 have the opportunity to attend revision sessions on Tuesday evenings. On 16th January 2024, this means that they have received over 600 hours of additional support since September.

Good communication has been critical to our ongoing success and the Maths team send home via email a detailed analysis of each assessment that students complete, so that each term, parents know strengths and areas for development, with links to the revision materials. Last year, over 6000 emails were sent home to parents and carers.
