The PE Department are a team of enthusiastic and passionate and inspiring teachers who have been together at Etonbury for 5 years and they share a range of specialisms including Dance, Football,



Netball and Gymnastics. We teach all students from Year 5 to 12 in PE lessons and are lucky enough to have fantastic facilities including 3G, Pendleton, Gym, Hall, Playground and large field for our lessons, clubs and fixtures. As a team, we are so grateful for all the students who help us in clubs weekly with the younger students and its wonderful to see the excellent relationships they build.

Physical Education is an integral part of the day to day life.

Our main focus is to prepare and motivate all students to engage in activities, which promote health and well-being.

In Core PE, all students, years 5-11, take part in Football, Netball, Gymnastics, Badminton, Basketball, Athletics, Rounders, Cricket, Football, Table Tennis,



Volleyball, Hockey, Rugby and more! These sports are rotated each half term so students get a wide range of

opportunities. At KS4 we offer GCSE PE and BTEC Sport, and at KS5 (Sixth form) we offer Double (worth 2 a-levels) and Single (1 a level) BTEC Sport courses.

I am proud to be head for our successful PE department. I have been a teacher for 6 years now and spent 5 years of this at Etonbury Academy. In this time, I have been lucky enough

to be the form tutor of 11SH since they were in Year 7.



Reports


