FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

For tuition fee (non salaried) trainees Student finance: Candidates may be eligible for the parent learning allowance and childcare grant for eligible trainees. Funding is tax free and does not have to be paid back. Entitlement can be up to 85% of childcare costs of up to £179.62 a week (1 child) or up to £307.95 a week (2 or more children). Parent learning allowance is up to £1,821 for the year.
