

Year 12 Virtual Work Experience - July 1st to July 5th 2024

All students who have not secured a work experience placement will be required to attend school each day from 8:40am to 3:00pm - to participate in a virtual work experience. Please find below an overview of what will be happening each day.

What's happening each day?

- **Monday 1st July: Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW)** Students will learn how problem-solving and communication are key skills to succeed, and discover how to make a difference to organisations and communities globally.
- **Tuesday 2nd July: Tesco** Students will gain hands-on product design and marketing experience by designing a promotional meal deal, crafting a social media post, and developing pitch skills to present ideas effectively. They will also learn about the diverse career opportunities available at Tesco.
- **Wednesday 3rd July: Get Into Teaching** Students will explore different tasks that teachers deliver and key skills they develop throughout their careers. They'll take a deep dive into the profession to showcase how varied and rewarding teaching can be.
- **Thursday 4th July: NHS** Students will create a person specification and job description that appeals to young people, and explore methods for marketing job opportunities, designing interview questions and tasks. They will learn how having the right values is crucial for working in any role in the NHS.
- **Friday 5th July: BBC** Students will learn the significance of credibility in journalism, how to fact-check, and explore the importance of ethical journalism practices. The BBC will provide information about career pathways and apprenticeships.
