Attendance Procedures - If your child is going to be absent, please contact the Academy before 8.40am on (01462) 730391 and select attendance or email eta-absence@bestacademies.org.uk to advise us of the reason for absence and when you expect them to return to school. If children have to attend a medical or dental appointment during the school day please communicate this to our Attendance Officer in the same way. When reporting an absence:

- We require a specific reason or symptom
- Please notify the attendance officer daily of any absence
- Medical Appointment cards and records should also be sent by email in advance so we can inform the staff prior to collection.

Bikes & Scooters - Students are welcome to bike or scoot to school and park in the bike sheds or their designated year group area. Please can you ensure your child has their own personal lock to secure their bike or scooter during the school day. If for any reason they have an issue with their lock please remind them to visit the school reception.

Driving on Site - If you do drive onto the school site please help us to keep our school community and families safe by driving slowly and with extreme caution. There is a large volume of traffic at the beginning and end of the school day and we have noticed an increase in the speed some vehicles travel. Our speed limit on site is 5MPH. Please continue to use the D at the top of the drive to drop off and collect at the beginning and the end of the day only. This ensures the disruption to the flow of traffic is kept to a minimum and reduces the number of vehicles on our school site. Thank you for your cooperation.

Collection - If your child is in ETA Juniors please do not wait directly outside the school reception area at the end of the day to collect your child/ren. Please wait on the grass area outside the Pendleton Sports Centre.

We will follow this up in school if the work is not completed to a good standard but we have found that this
