In history the students are studying the cold war. In psychology they are learning about questionnaires. In photography they are learning how to use a proper camera and in art they are learning the skill of mark making linked to coastal environments.

It is important that students are completing their homework tasks and are coming to school equipped for their lessons, including a scientific calculator for their maths lessons. I would also suggest getting CGP revision guides for each of their subjects. Please check with your child which exam board they do for each subject or look at the school website to find out more.

Important dates for your diary year 10 mocks will run over two weeks from 22/04/25 to the 08/05/25. All year 10 students will be on work experience from the 19/05/25 to the 23/05/25, students will need to seek a placement and then upload the details of the business to Unifrog. Unifrog will then contact employers to complete the paperwork.

Congratulations to all the year 10 students who successfully completed their Spoken Language exam this term. If any students have not yet completed their exam (for example, if they are new starters), their class teacher will speak to them after half term about arranging an assessment date. 

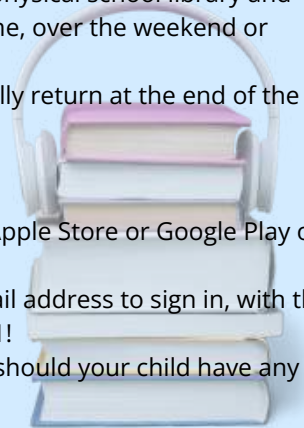
