PRINCIPAL WELCOME

I hope you enjoy reading our now half termly bulletin that offers an insight into the wonderful pupils we have here at Etonbury. I am always amazed at the wealth of talent and the passion for learning I see everyday as I walk around the school and visit lessons. This is one of our busiest terms with the final push towards Year 6 SATS, GCSE and A Levels. Interventions are running every night after school across multiple subjects and year groups as the staff support learners in the last few weeks before the examination series begins.

One of my key aims moving from a post covid world is to offer as many opportunities as we can outside of the classroom and to provide opportunities to experience different cultures, countries and opportunities, whether that be from a trip, visit or speaker. We have had so many 'firsts' this half term and notably our first ski trip in many years. Thank you to the staff who gave up their half term to take a group of 40 pupils to Italy on the ski trip. Our highly competitive debate team were in school bright and early one morning to 'compete' in an online competition with a school from Dubai.

There are leadership opportunities every week in the Sixth Form and we moved on from our highly successful Junior Disco of last half term to a charity football match staff v staff organised by Year 13 pupils. It has now become an annual event and raises money for a designated charity, as well as providing the chance for sixth form pupils to develop leadership skills and organisational skills. The pitch invasion of spectators at the end keen to take selfies with their favourite player was a real highlight.

As a school reading and developing a passion for reading and literature is fundamental to our daily lives and to be able to offer every Year 11 pupil the opportunity to attend 'Poetry Live' in London in preparation for their GCSE was a welcome addition to our trip and visit calendar. To add to this, Years 7 and 9 welcomed a performance poet into school and with prompts taken from the pupils the poet created and recited unique poetry made up entirely of the audience prompts.

We will end the term with a theatre trip for Year 11 pupils going to London to see 'Back to the Future,' Year 12s beginning their university, apprenticeship or employment journey in preparation for applications to be made over the next year or so. The school leadership team will be undertaking a reflective student voice activity, where pupils will be asked to provide feedback on all aspects of school life to the senior leaders in the school. The success of Etonbury is the partnership between parent/carers, pupils, staff and the wider community and it is important that we take time to listen to our stakeholders and reflect the feedback in our plans for the future.

We hope you and your families have a lovely Easter holiday and take time to rest and recover. We look forward to welcoming our students back on Tuesday 22nd April.

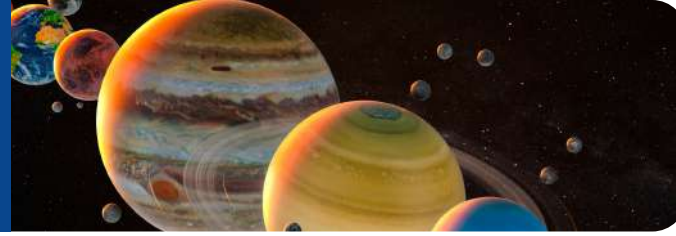

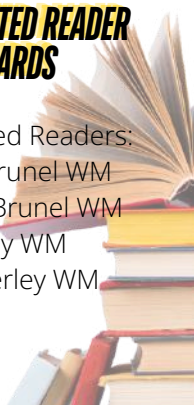

Sixth Form news continued....

In February, Etonbury Juniors enjoyed their Valentines disco, which was organised by the Year 12s. Over 200 students enjoyed dancing and party games, having selected their favourite songs beforehand. They also enjoyed having their photo taken with friends with various props in the photo booth. It was lovely to see the older and younger students having fun together and demonstrated how special our school community is. Whilst organising the disco, Sixth Formers worked in teams to ensure that health and safety policies were met, the event would be financially viable, the hall and equipment were set up in advance and the event was advertised to juniors. Through doing this, students learnt key employability skills and pushed themselves to take on new responsibilities, which they will be able to reflect on in their CVs and personal statements. We are proud of the students and how they are becoming fantastic role models for the younger students.

Last week, we took all of the Year 12s to the UCAS Discovery event in London to support them with their post 18 options. Students were able to chat to universities about their courses and student life, employers and apprenticeship providers about what an apprenticeship is like, and ask qualified careers advisers about their future options. They were also able to listen to talks from experts in their fields and get support from UCAS experts about the application process. Our students were fantastic ambassadors for the school and came away with lots of ideas and freebies!

On top of all this, we are eagerly looking ahead to September and our next cohort of Sixth Formers. We have been busy meeting with all Year 11 Etonbury applicants over the last few weeks to get to know them better, find out about their future career plans and support them with their subject choices. We are really enjoying meeting with the students and have been so impressed with their aspirational attitude. We have also been meeting lots of students from other schools, who have heard great things about our Sixth Form provision. We know that Etonbury is special, due to the fantastic relationships our staff build with the students in smaller Forms. It was wonderful to meet with our Year 12 students and their parents this term. We encouraged our students to view this opportunity as a chance to pause, reflect, adapt, and advance with a positive growth mindset. By utilising the feedback and guidance provided by their teachers, students can better navigate their journey toward success. The reports issued earlier this term, along with this parents' evening, serve as essential checkpoints for students to gain a clear understanding of what is needed to achieve their target grades, and even exceed these initial expectations. We also closely monitor attendance and punctuality, as reliable data shows a strong link between consistent attendance and reaching one's full potential. Thank you for your support in promoting punctuality and a growth mindset.

SPECIALIST STAFF

All our teachers have a specialism in the subjects they teach at KS5. Most subjects have 2 teachers so students have lots of support. Many of our teachers are examiners in their subjects, so are experts in how students will be assessed. Teachers also have links with people who have careers in their field in the real world, so can help students with careers advice and work experience contacts.




RELATIONSHIPS ESTABLISHED

Students are always telling us that the reason they stayed on into Sixth Form is because they have excellent relationships with their teachers. Teachers already know their strengths and weaknesses, so can really hit the ground running at KS5, where there is very little time to cover lots of content. Every transition to a new setting has been proven to set students back several months, so staying with us would mean no time is wasted.



BRAND NEW FACILITIES

The Sixth Form centre was a £1,000,000 refurbishment project and bespoke designed for our students, reflecting the wishes that came from student voice working parties. The café and garden were requested by the students and are unique to this setting - very few Sixth Forms have this provision. We have recently added table tennis tables to the garden, thanks to the PE department, which are proving very popular.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT (PD) LESSONS

We're excited to announce that this year's round of CPR practice has officially begun, starting with our Year 10 students! All secondary students have the opportunity to participate in a vital CPR lesson, designed to teach them essential life-saving skills. In addition to CPR, students also learn how to use an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) unit, a crucial tool that can help restore normal heart rhythms during a cardiac emergency. Knowing how to perform CPR and use an AED can make a difference in emergency situations, as it can significantly increase the chances of survival for someone experiencing cardiac arrest. By offering this training annually, we ensure that our students are equipped with the knowledge and confidence to respond in critical moments, potentially saving lives in the future.

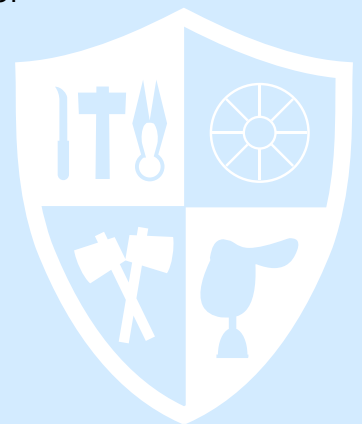
