Being an extended secondary school, we have Year 6 SATS, GCSE and A Level examinations in the school this half term. Pupils have worked so hard in preparing for their public examinations and I wish them all well as these continue. A huge well done to our Year 6 pupils who have this week completed their SATS week. They have been celebrating their achievements with various activities in school which included a visit from an ice cream van by way of a 'well done' from all of us at Etonbury Academy.

Year 10 pupils have completed their mock exams this half term. We hope these have given them a great opportunity to familiarise themselves with the format and content of GCSE papers whilst providing both them and their teachers a clear indicator of current and future academic performance. Our invigilators were full of praise for their organisation and how well equipped they all were and how exemplary their conduct was during the mock exams.

GCSE and A Level exams are well underway. I wish every success to our students who are taking these exams. It has been a pleasure seeing our Year 11 students mature into the diligent and respectful young people that they are today. Teachers remain on hand after half term to support with revision and pupils will be very familiar with where to find the revision materials for their exams.

Leavers assemblies have taken place for Year 11 and 13 pupils and they always provide a touching moment, filled with laughter, tears, and heartfelt farewells. The traditional shirt signing event was enjoyed by all leavers, it was a true display of friendship and camaraderie, as students decorated each other's shirts with well-wishes and memories to carry forward. These moments of togetherness will forever be memories of their time at ETA as they embark on the next chapter of their academic journey. The school community is proud of their hard work and dedication, and we look forward to seeing all the amazing things they will achieve in the future.

It's been an exciting few weeks for our Duke of Edinburgh students. They have been practising their skills and preparing for their upcoming final expeditions. ## 'A WELCOMING AND NURTURING PLACE TO LEARN' – OFSTED INSPECTORS LAVISH PRAISE ON ETONBURY ACADEMY

Etonbury Academy is 'a welcoming and nurturing place to learn', concluded Ofsted Inspectors as they lavished praise on the school, following an inspection on 23rd and 24th April 2025. Inspectors were impressed with all areas of provision, describing how much pupils enjoy attending their school and the high expectations teachers have, which pupils rise to meet.

The report celebrates pupils' strong sense of belonging to the school community, how they feel safe, cared for and known as individuals and the consistently strong outcomes they achieve. Etonbury's curriculum is commended for its ambition, as is the extensive and well-planned programme to develop pupils' character. Behaviour at the school is judged to be excellent, attendance is high and pupils consistently demonstrate kindness towards each other.

Principal Jo Young explained how delighted she was with the report: "The report describes what our pupils, parents, staff and visitors tell us, that we are a welcoming school, treat each other with kindness and expect the very best. I am tremendously grateful to all in the Etonbury Community and am confident that we will continue, with such great support, to get better and better – together, there is no limit to what our pupils and staff can achieve and be."

Dr John Christoper, Chair of Govenors at Etonbury said "The inspection team had clearly formed an accurate picture of Etonbury and it was quite moving to hear the comments which reflected from many different perspectives the incredible effort and teamwork that goes on every day to make the school such a vibrant, happy and successful environment."

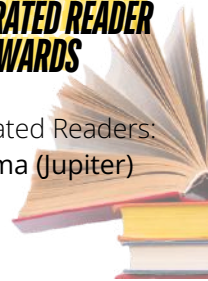

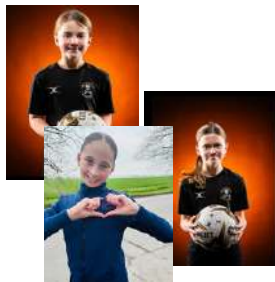

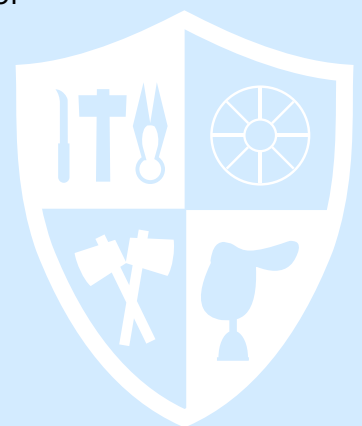
