

Etonbury Academy Homework Timetable - 2025/2026

The Purpose of Homework

- To encourage pupils to develop the skills, confidence and motivation needed to study effectively on their own. This is vital, given the importance for pupils in the future, of lifelong learning and adaptability in the workplace.
- To extend school learning, for example through additional reading.
- To consolidate, practise and reinforce skills and understanding developed at school.
- To sustain the involvement of parents and carers in the management of pupils' learning and keeping them informed about the work pupils are doing.
- To manage particular demands, such as GCSE/A-Level coursework.

We also expect all pupils to read regularly and would expect them to read for 20 – 30 minutes each evening.

General Information

A Homework Timetable will be produced at the beginning of each year to ensure that the total amount of homework set for students, either daily or weekly, is consistent and manageable for them.

A piece of homework at Key Stage 2 and Key stage 3 should take between 10-30 minutes to complete.

A piece of homework at Key Stage 4 should take between 30 minutes to 1 hour to complete.

At Key Stage 5 students can expect two homework slots per week (usually one from each teacher). A piece of homework can expect to take 1-2 hours.

Homework will never be set for completion for the following day.

Homework will be set via E-Praise and/or on Google Classroom, and will follow the schedule outlined in this document.

KS2 Homework timetable 2025/2026

Four pieces of homework will be set regularly each fortnight. Homework will be set on the following days for Week A and Week B via Google Classroom. In both year groups the English and maths homework are set on a Friday and hand in date is the following Wednesday.

- Make a glossary of key terms from a topic
- Condense the days notes onto revision cards
- Print and complete a past paper
- Test spellings of keywords in your subject
