**Re: Grade Booster – Tutor2U A-level Business, Psychology and Sociology Workshop
Thursday 26 March 2026**

Please note that this trip is a rescheduled date from the originally planned visit on 26 November. For students who have already paid, all monies will be automatically transferred to the new date and no action is required. For students who did not previously book, places are now available, and we would encourage you to secure a place if interested.

I am writing to invite your child to attend a Grade Booster workshop delivered by Tutor2U, designed to improve exam performance. The workshop will take place at Vue Cinema, Westfield White City, on Thursday 26 March 2026, starting at 9:45am and finishing at 3:30pm.

We will be travelling by train. Students must arrive at Arseley Train Station at 8:00am to meet staff and will return to the station at approximately 6:00pm.

Students will have a 50–60 minute lunch break, during which they may purchase food from nearby fast-food outlets. This will be supervised by accompanying staff. Students may also bring a packed lunch if they prefer.

Cost and Payment

The total cost of the trip is £55, which includes entrance tickets, transport, and insurance. This is a voluntary contribution; however, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip may not go ahead.
