

Dear Parents/Carers,

After May half term as part of PSHCE lessons, pupils will be receiving their Relationships and Sex education lessons.

They will cover information on:

- Understanding what makes a healthy relationship.
- What the expectations might be of having a girlfriend/boyfriend.
- To consider different levels of intimacy and their consequences.
- To understand the nature and importance of marriage, civil partnerships and other stable, long-term relationships for family life and bringing up children.
- To consider the issues surrounding readiness for sex and the benefits of delaying
- To understand the law in relation to consent (including the legal age of consent for sexual activity).
- To know what contraception is and how it acts as protection against pregnancy and a barrier to some STI's. They will also see examples of contraception, this will also involve a condom demonstration by the teacher in class.

We find that these sessions are further enhanced when parents follow them up at home.
