Results Day – Thursday 13th August 2026

Results will be available from 8.30am in the Sixth Form centre. Please enter the school via the new reception and parents are able to wait for students in the Sixth Form garden.

If you log on to UCAS first thing in the morning, you can find out whether you have been accepted at your 'CF' university; the offer will have been changed from '**Conditional**' to '**Unconditional**'. If you have been rejected, then you should have had a change of offer from your 'CI' (insurance place). If you have been rejected from both CF and CI then you will automatically be eligible for a clearing place. The UCAS website will publish all the clearing places. It is just a question of looking and making phone calls. Members of Etonbury staff will be available on the day, and the day after, to offer any advice and guidance.

If students cannot come into school to collect their results, the following may be arranged:

- A nominated person can collect them on your behalf but they must have a letter of authorisation from the student. Please note that this nominated person may be asked for a photographic ID before results are given out.
- Results can be posted home, but you must supply a stamped self-addressed envelope to the exams office no later than 17th July 2026.
- A PDF of results can be emailed to the students' school email address. This must be requested by the student no later than 17th July 2026.

Finally, we would like to say you have been a great year group, and that it has been a pleasure teaching and working with you all. You will always be part of Etonbury's story as our second Sixth Form cohort and it has been special to grow with you. Please do keep in touch and tell us how you are getting on whatever you do next.
