Lunchtime ends at 1:30pm. The teacher will blow a whistle when it's time to line up.

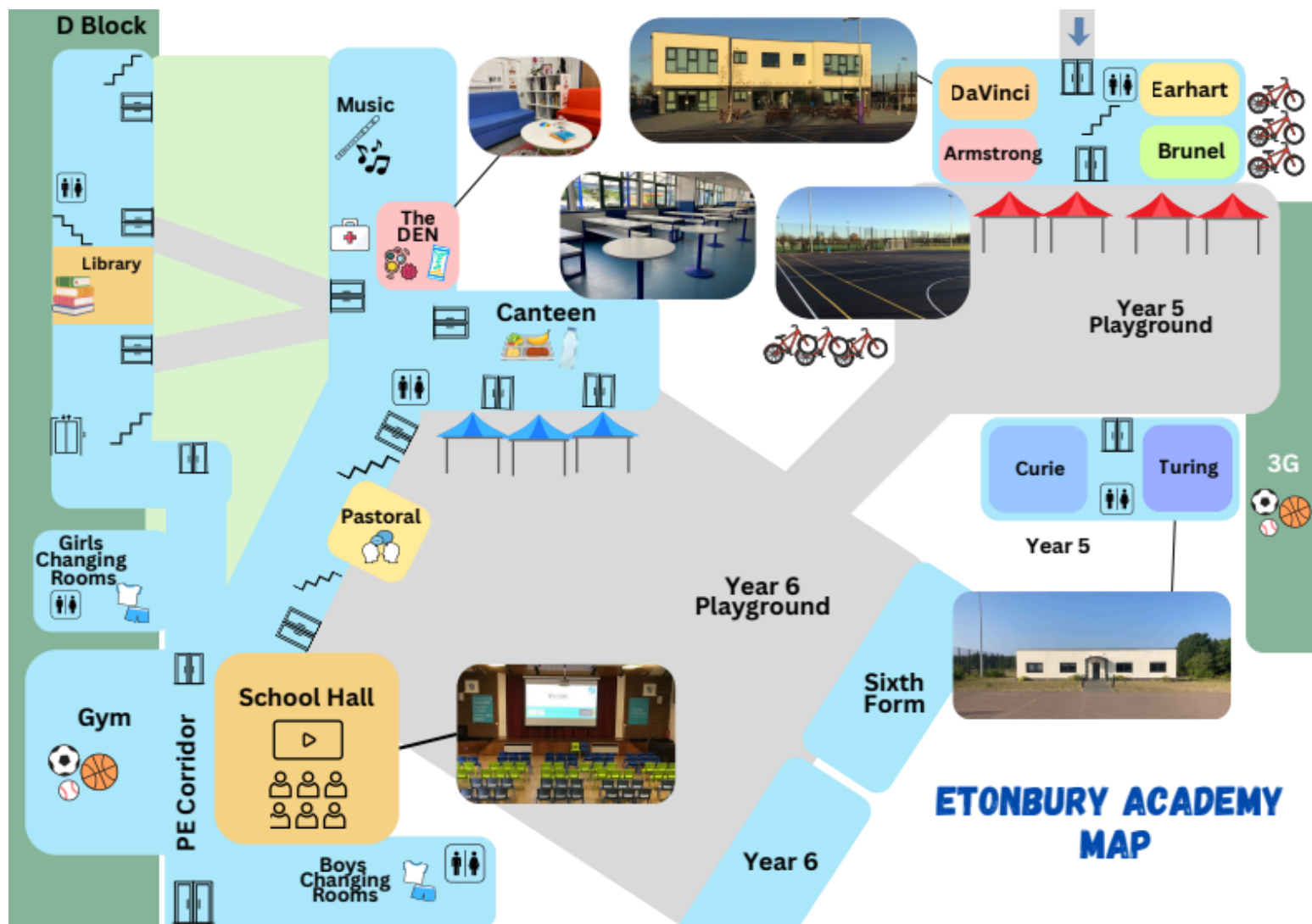


3:15pm

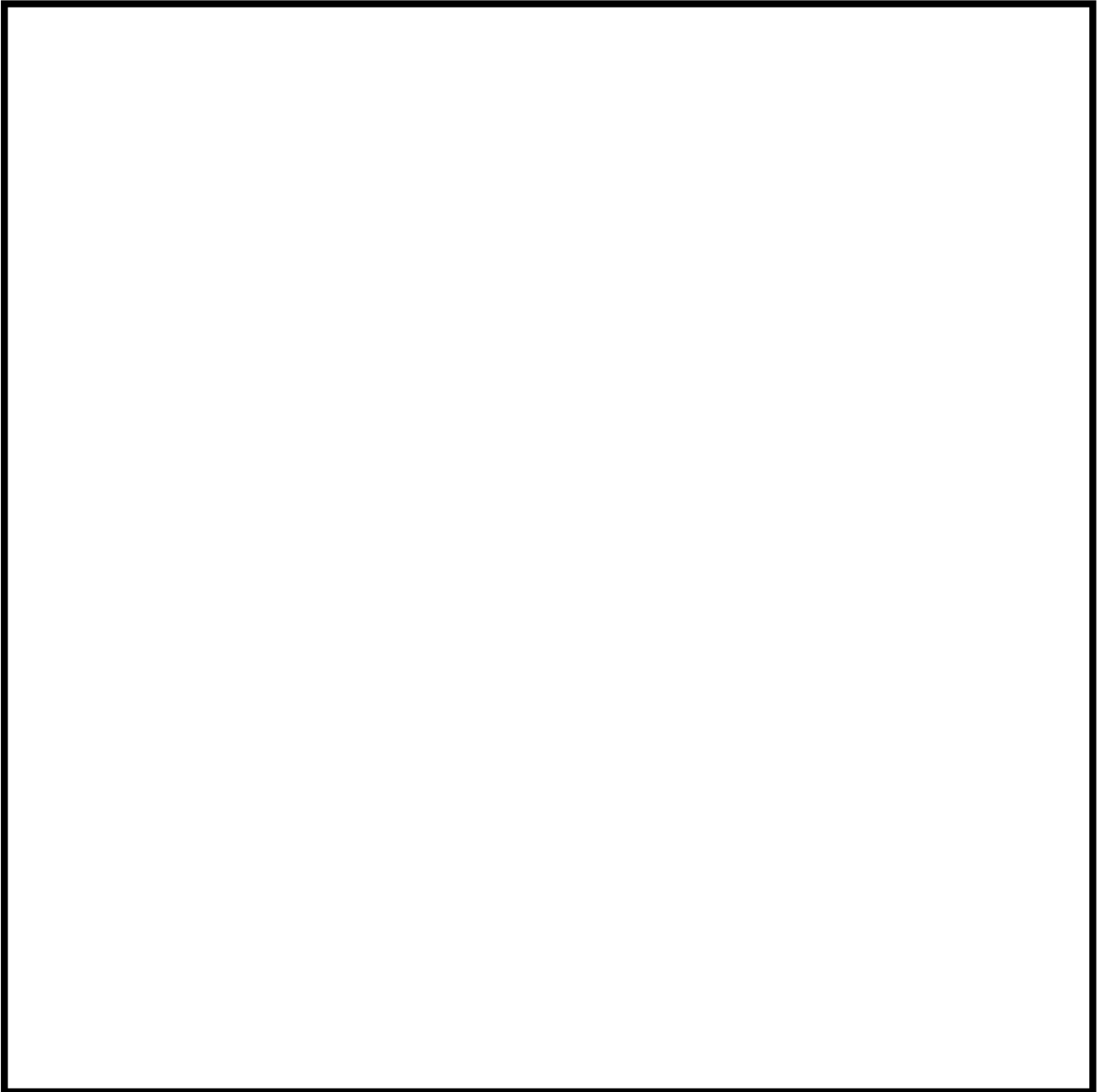
