

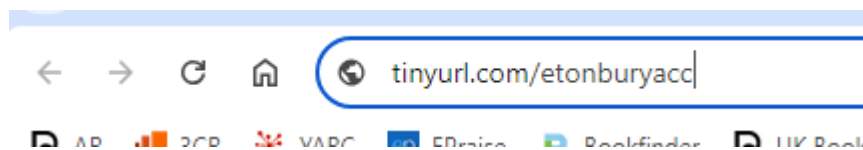
How to log into AR at home

OR alternatively

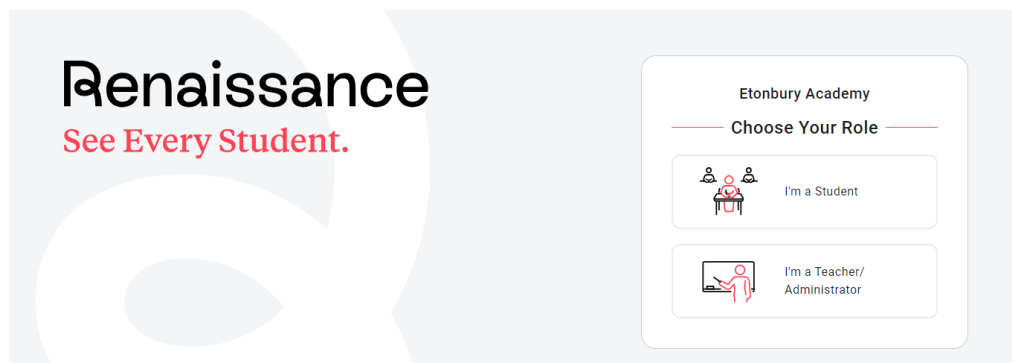
- Open Google

(as shown below)

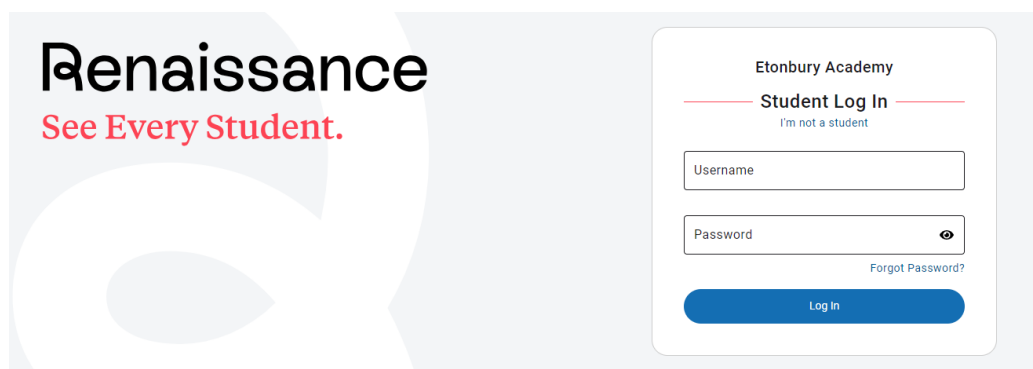


- Press enter.

Accelerated Reader will display as follows:



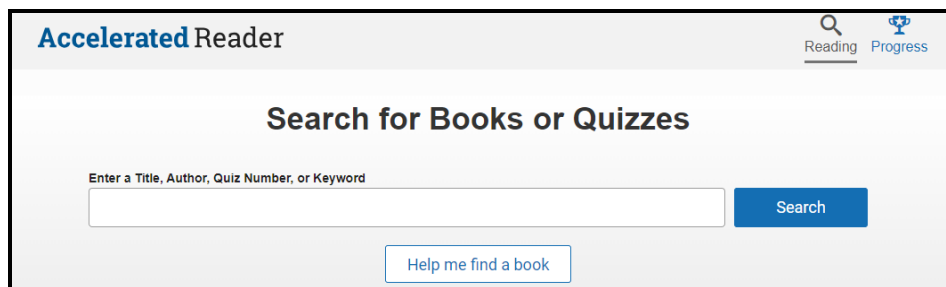
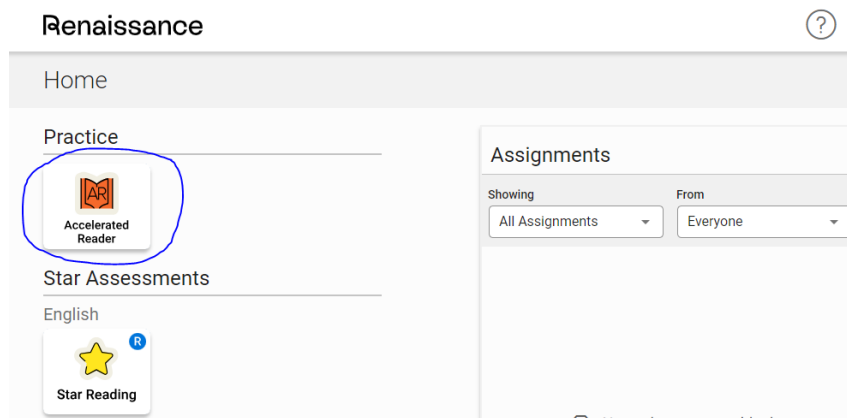
- Click on I'm a Student



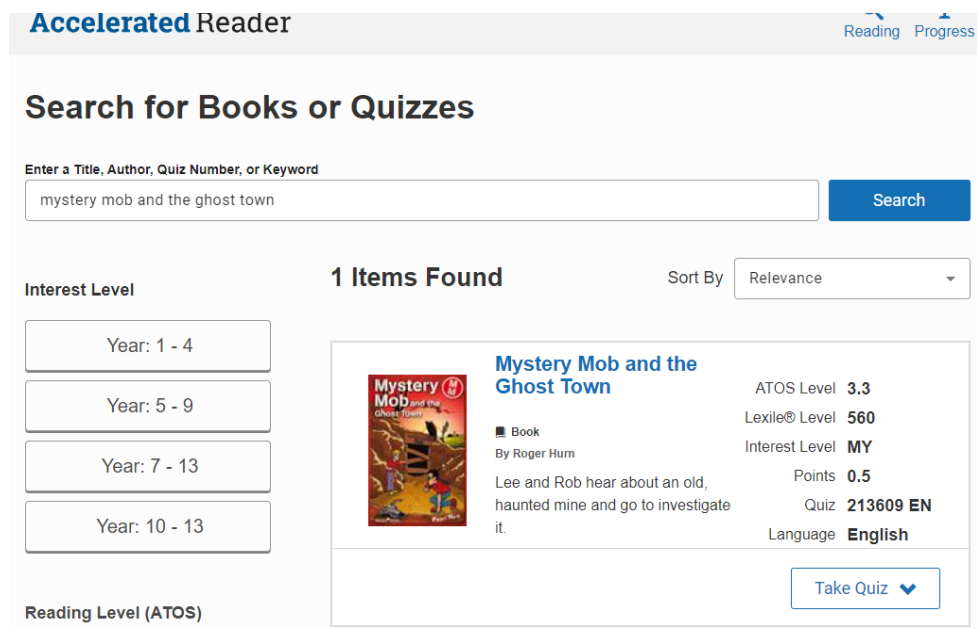
Username = student's first initial followed by first 4 letter of last name (e.g. *Bob Smith* would be *bsmit*)

- Enter username, password and click on Log in

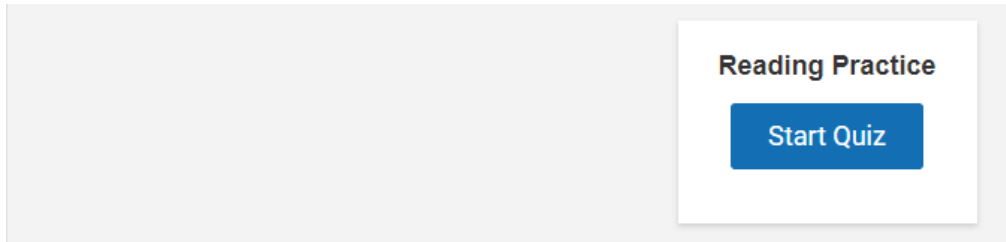
To quiz on a book click on the Accelerated Reader icon:



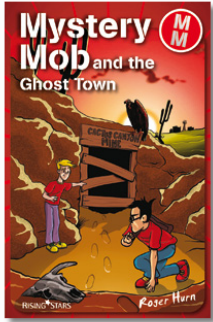
Type in the book title/author. Here is an example:
