Etonbury After School Gardening Club

Etonbury After School Gardening Club takes place on Thursday evenings from 3.30 – 4.30pm, **this could also include certain lunchtimes during the school week dependent upon the weather. All years are welcome to join us, and we always welcome adult helpers, (subject to DBS clearance).**

We have a garden/allotment within the environmental area that also encompasses a Poly Tunnel area which has been used for growing crops. We are hoping to get this up and running again during the Spring Term with help from pupils that are interested. There are dedicated growing areas on raised beds which have proved to be very successful and productive over the summer and autumn months. It would be beneficial if your child could bring a pair of wellingtons, in the weather looks wet. A wet weather jacket and a change of clothing, i.e. old trousers and warm sweatshirt are also recommended. All other materials and clothing will be provided i.e. gloves etc

We will be working with vegetables, flowers and herbs, growing these from seed and watching the development of each plant to maturity. We will then hopefully be looking at how these can then be used in cooking and possibly selling the produce!

We spend time in the wildlife pond area, and are starting to develop this along with the farm personnel. This will involve a certain amount of cutting back and pruning bushes around the pond and garden areas and would welcome any help and much needed knowledge in any of these areas.
